The Cooperative, which had no funds to begin with, was housed in the offices of Spoon River Electric Cooperative on South Fifth Avenue in Canton, Illinois. In 1956 these facilities were out grown and the temporary headquarters office was moved to 122 North Avenue A. On August 25, 1962, the Cooperative then moved to its West Locust Limits location, in Canton where it resided for 44 years. In 2006, Mid Century built and moved within its service area at 285 Mid Century Lane, Fairview Illinois, which remains the headquarters for the Cooperative telephone system. As of August 1, 2007, Mid Century Telephone Co-operative serves fourteen (14) telephone exchanges:

Mid Century Telephone Co-operative firsts include the following:

- First to offer four party rural service of any REA borrower in ILLINOIS.
- First to offer all one party service in operating area.
- First to utilize 100% digital switching.
- First to install fiber optic buried plant facilities.
- First Cooperative to purchase an exchange and incorporate directly into the existing Cooperative, August 2007.

Other services made available to members:

- January 1996 - Class Feature Services Offered.
- April 1996 - Local Number Dial-up Internet (WINS)
- June 1996 - Century Enterprises, Inc. (Long Distance Service)
- October 1998 - Homebound 800 Numbers
- February 2004 - Broadband Services opened to large majority of members, (High Speed Internet first service offered)
- November 2004 - MCTV (Digital Television programming delivered to your home through telephone line).
- 2006 - 100% Broadband Services throughout entire service area at that time.
