
Step 1. Go to the App Store / Play Store and search ,**ViewLocal** download and install

Step 2. Once downloaded, open the ViewLocal app sign in with your email address and password.

Step 3. If you have forgotten your password, click **Reset Pass**, type your full email address and click **Continue**. An email will be sent that will allow you to change your password.

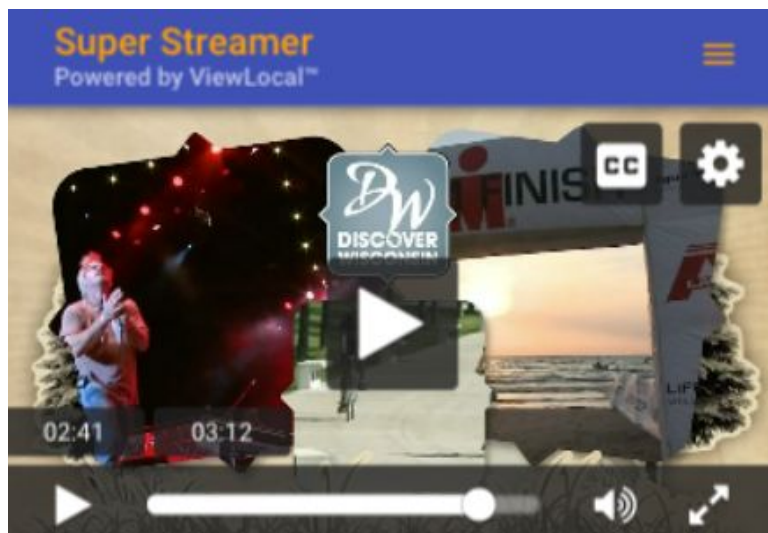
Step 4. Once you have logged in, you may swipe up or down to view the channels. To select a channel, tap the channel and a guide will appear showing you what is on now and next. Tap **Watch Now** to select the channel.



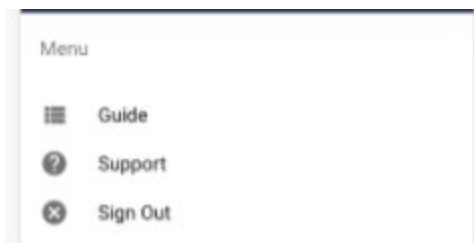
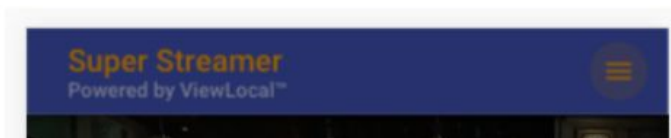
Step 5. To view in full screen, simply rotate the phone horizontally.

Step 6. Closed Caption (CC), Pause, Play, Rewind and Settings

- a. Closed Captioning - tap to turn on / off
- b. Pause - tap play symbol to pause
- c. Play - tap play symbol to resume
- d. Rewind - slide bar to the left - Slide to right to return to current time
- e. Settings - allows you to set bitrate - we recommend not using this feature. App will automatically choose the best setting.



Step 7. To view the Guide, Support or Sign Out tap the three lines in the upper right corner. A pop up will appear at the bottom of your screen.



Step 8. To view the guide, tap Guide. Swipe right and or left to view listings for the next 24 hours.
