## What Purpose Does the Nominating Committee Serve and Why is it Necessary?

The bylaws of the Mid Century Telephone Cooperative mandate the appointment of a Nominating Committee to nominate members for the Board of Directors election during the Annual Meeting. According to the Bylaws, the committee must consist of at least five but no more than 11 members, with at least one member representing each district up for election.

The Board will designate the Committee during the May 23, 2024 Board Meeting.
